## **Disability Services**

<u>The Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504)</u> and <u>The Americans with Disabilities</u> <u>Act (ADA) of 1990</u> as amended by the <u>ADAAA of 2008</u>

Queen City College complies with all provisions of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 in that no qualified disabled person, by reason of the disability, will be excluded from enrolling in a course of instruction. Compliance with federal disability law meets the requirements for compliance with the disability portion of the TN Human Rights Act.

The Institutional Director and the Director of Admissions is responsible for administering the process of student requests for accommodations under Section 504 and the ADA, including oversight of the provision of reasonable modifications to Queen City College programs or activities in order to allow qualified students to fully participate in those programs or activities.
